Still awaiting it's proper discovery, this unspoilt and exotic island is a must see when travelling to Indonesia! Boasting picturesque beaches, rugged lush green hills and vivid turquoise waters, you'll be sure to get the perfect scenery photos here!

You're in for a treat with this feature packed long weekend trip! You'll have the chance to explore all of the major attractions and also some of the lesser-known secrets.

You'll feel a sense of adventure as you head off around the island in a private car. As you head up through the hills along the bumpy roads, you'll be surprised with each view on offer around every corner.

Over the course of the three days, you will get the chance to visit the famous pillowly white sandy beaches, snorkel in the crystal-clear waters in search of manta rays (and even the occasional whale shark!), get blessed at one of the many sacred temples, swim in natural pools and so much more!

Just some of the amazing places you'll visit are Broken Beach, Angels Billabong, Crystal Bay, Goa Giri Putri Temple, Atuh Beach and so much more!

With so much to see and do, you won't find a more fun filled trip on offer anywhere else! Each weekend trip leaves on a Friday morning and returns on the Sunday evening, costing just £159 per person.

ITINERARY



DAY 1 – BEACHES & SUNSET

The fun starts here! Leaving the volunteer accommodation around 8am, we will make the journey down to Sanur harbour to jump aboard the speedboat. It's around a 45-minute journey to Nusa Penida and if you're brave enough to sit on the top deck then you're in for a treat and maybe even a dance with loud music being played.

You'll be greeted by the local co-ordinator and then start your journey to see **ALL** of the island!

Today we will be ticking off the famous beaches; Broken Beach, Angels Billagong, Kelingking beach and finally to see the sunset at Crystal Bay.

After dark we will head to the hotel to check in for the night.

DAY 2 - TEMPLES, VIEWS, BEACHES & HILLS

Another action packed day awaits! After breakfast we will jump into the car to visit Goa Giri Putri Temple. This large cave temple will see you squeezing through a narrow entrance and as you wander through the passages you will be amazed at the grand size of the courtyard inside!

Afterwards we will head to Thousand Islands Viewpoint – one of the highlights for taking in the most spectacular scenery and relaxing in the ocean breeze.

The day will finish off with a visit to Atuh Beach and then a quick stop at Teletubbies Hills — an undulating pasture covered in verdant green grasses, ferns and lavender.

DAY 3 – NATURAL POOLS, WATERFALLS & CLIFFS

Time has flown by and it's our last day in Nusa Penida. Before we catch the speedboat back (in the afternoon), we have a few more sites to check off the list.

Our first stop is Tembeling Pool and forest where you can go for a refreshing swim in the natural pool and take in breath-taking scenery around you.

Next is Banah Cliff, where you will quite literally feel on top of the world.

To finish off we will stop at Peguyangan Waterfalls. If you're scared of heights, then it's time to overcome your fear! Walking down the rickety stairs on the side of the cliff, you will be able to take in the spectacular cliff views and visit the pilgrimage site nearby.

ACCOMMODATION

You will be staying in a guesthouse on Friday and Saturday night that is just a stone's throw away from the beach. It will be basic but clean and comfortable and perfect for getting a good nights rest. You'll have all of the amenities you need such as western bathrooms and Wi-Fi – although this may be intermittent.

MEALS

Breakfast is included within the programme fee and will be served at the guesthouse / hotel. Lunch and dinner are an additional cost and time will be made each day for everyone to grab something to eat. Although prices are a little higher than Bali (due to having to import everything) cost of living here is a lot cheaper than England — we recommend budgeting around £10 per day for food.

TRANSPORT

All transport is included within the programme fee. You will be transported to and from the



volunteer accommodation and harbour by a private car / minibus as well as during your time in Nusa Penida.

If you want to take part on this amazing trip and the dates fall on your last weekend in Bali then you can still take part! Please arrange your return flight from Bali for the Monday to ensure you have sufficient time of getting to the airport. The accommodation on your last night is not included and we can recommend several hotels either close to our accommodation or to the airport.
